Scope of Work:

Vignetic partnered with the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) / Uganda mission to establish a complete integrated ERP software package that includes all supply chain management functionality for National Medical Stores (NMS), allowing 3,500 health facilities to order, manage supply, demand and distribution of critical pharmaceuticals and medical supplies online.

This project included architecting and procuring all ERP software and associated modules, the database management system, creating and executing complex project management methodology, providing training, implementation, operations and maintenance through the 60-month contract.

This four phase, five time zone, three continent-staffed project is being implemented on time and on budget despite the COVID-19 pandemic.

Results and Outcomes:

- Managed project over 60 months including the Oracle Unified Methodology, which has five main phases and 15 defined processes.
- Implemented, standardized, automated and integrated Oracle E-business system suite resulting in real-time data access.
- Managed self-service recruitment interface for both job seekers and employee portal to access personal, leave and payroll data.
- Strengthened Uganda's response to its citizens' health needs.
